World Mission Sunday will be celebrated this year on the weekend of October 22-23.

This year's theme is: "You shall be My witnesses" (Acts 1:8). As Cardinal McElroy has shared, "Pope Francis in his World Mission Sunday message, emphasizes the call to every Christian to bear witness to Christ, to participate in a mission of universal evangelization, and to seek strength and guidance from the Holy Spirit".

Pope Francis also points to the example of Blessed Pauline Jaricot, foundress of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, as a way to respond to that missionary call, through prayer and charity.
